**SET-UP:** Access to the building is through the front door. Exhibitors may set up in the upstairs crating room on Saturday and Sunday not before 7am. Please, **NO X-PENS**. ACNH requests that everyone use only the necessary space to accommodate their crates to eliminate problems. Stack crates when possible. Please be considerate of other exhibitors and leave space for everyone! Thank you from ACNH.

**FOR Master/Ex JWW and Standard** 4 & 48 will walk, 12 will walk, run, run/ 16 will walk, run /20 will walk, 24 will walk, run, run

**OPEN Standard and JWW:** All heights will walk, run      **Novice Standard and JWW:** All heights will walk, run

**MEASURING:** Tom O'Brien will be the VMO for this trial. Each dog must have an official Jump Height Card or a yellow Temporary Measuring Form prior to running any of the agility courses. Each dog 15 months to 2 years must have 1 Temporary Measuring form. If you do not have a permanent or temporary card your dog **MUST** be measured by the VMO prior to running. The measurement done before your first run will be effective through the weekend. It is the owners' responsibility to ensure their dog is measured prior to running and to run in the appropriate jump height.

**MOVE-UPS:** Move ups prior to a set of trials. Dogs shall be moved up to higher classes as the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for a lower level agility trial provided that the request is made, in writing, to the Trial Secretary **NO LATER THAN 6PM on Monday December 31, 2018**. Move-ups can be emailed to [bebedoyon@gmail.com](mailto:bebedoyon@gmail.com). Dogs qualifying for a higher class by earning a title on Saturday may be moved up the following day provided the request is received, in writing, before the end of the first day trial. All correspondence will be acknowledged with a receipt of all move-ups and corrections to entries.

**WAIT LIST:** To fill openings created by entries withdrawn prior to a date and time established by the club. Such date may be beyond the event closing date, however it must be a minimum of three (3) days prior to the first trial date in a set of trials. All entries must be received prior to the closing date and time. The club will establish a maximum number of entries to be placed on the waiting list. This information is published in the Premium List. A full refund will be given to any entry who's spot in the trials has been so filled.

**FROM THE SOUTH /Boston** North to Manchester I-293/101 West. Follow signs toward Rt.101 West (Bedford/Milford). AK9C is located on Rt. 101 approximately 6 miles from the Rt. 114 interchange. AK9C is on the right across from Camp Rd at the blinking light.  
**FROM THE EAST COAST/Boston** West toward Bedford/Milford. AK9C is located on Rt. 101 approximately 6 miles from the Rt. 114 interchange. AK9C is on the right across from Camp Rd at the blinking light.  
**FROM THE WEST** East toward Manchester/Bedford. Watch for Salzburg Square Shopping Complex. AK9C is approximately 1 mile on the left after Salzburg Square at the blinking light across from Camp Road.
