## SITE REGULATIONS

**The speed for the driveway is 5mph.**

Obey all speed signs posted. Violators must leave the trial site and no refunds will be issued.

**During trial hours, dogs must be on lead on trial site at all times except at practice jump or in ring.**



Only exhibitor dogs are allowed in the barn.  
For safety reasons there will be no crating allowed in the seating area of the indoor ring.  
Work from your car, crate in a designated stall or tent/crate outside.  
Unattended dogs must be in crates or ex-pens.

No food or treats left in the building overnight. Stall windows must be closed when stall is not in use.

Water spigots inside and outside must be tightly closed after each use. Park in designated locations.

No smoking in any building or within 50 feet of any building. Scoop the poop anywhere on the grounds.

All trash is to be placed in proper receptacles. No unsupervised children allowed on the premises.

The consumption of alcoholic beverages is prohibited during trial hours. **SCA thanks all for their cooperation.**

## **MEASURING:** There will not be a VMO at this trial.

Each dog must have an official Jump Height Card OR a yellow Temporary Measurement Form prior to running any of the agility courses. Each dog 15 months to 2 years old must have permanent AKC Jump Height card or 1 Temporary Measurement form. Each dog 2 years of age or older must have an official jump height card or 2 yellow Temporary Measurement Forms (measurements done at 2 years of age or older) If you do not have the required official measurement card or temporary form(s), your dog MUST be measured by one of the judges prior to running. The measurement done before your first run will be effective for the rest of the weekend. It is the owner's responsibility to have his/her dog measured prior to running the courses. **MEASURING** will take place approximately 30 minutes prior to briefing and walk-thrus for each class.

## **WAIT LISTS**

To fill openings created by entries withdrawn prior to date & time established by the club. Such date may be beyond the event closing date; however, it must be minimum of three (3) days prior to first trial date of the set of trials. All entries must be received prior to closing date and time. The club must establish maximum number of entries that may be placed on wait list. Whether club is offering a wait list, how many entries are being accepted on the wait list and closing date/time of wait list must be published in trial's premium list. A full refund is to be reimbursed to any entrant whose entry is replaced by wait-listed entry

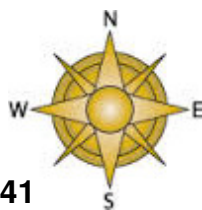

From the NYS Thruway (North or South) - Exit 16. Merge onto NY-17 West. Take Exit 122 - Crystal Run Crossing. Right onto Crystal Run Crossing. Left onto Crystal Run Road. Take to end. Right at stop sign - County Rd 83 / Goshen Turnpike / Scotchtown Road. Approximately 1.2 miles to Tetz Lane - Victoria Farms sign. Left onto Tetz Lane to end

From I-84 (East or West) - Exit 4 East. Merge onto NY-17 East toward New York. Take Exit 122 toward Crystal Run Road. Right onto Crystal Run Road. Take to end. Right at stop sign - County Rd 83 / Goshen Turnpike / Scotchtown Road. Approximately 1.2 miles to Tetz Lane - Victoria Farms sign. Left onto Tetz Lane to end
