COVID Requirements and Safety Procedures

Exhibitors must abide by NYS regulations for COVID and Doggie U safety procedures. Any exhibitor found in violation of these rules will be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All entries must include a signed THKC COVID-19 Protocol Pledge.

Masks are to be worn while inside DU including the ring area as well as the front parking area. Social distancing is always to be maintained.

Each exhibitor will have his/her temperature verified before entry to DU and a wristband will be issued allowing entrance to DU.

No guests or spectators allowed inside DU.

In addition to the ring crew and trial committee, only the exhibitor in the ring and a second in the waiting area will be allowed in the ring room. Entry and exit areas are for dogs and handlers entering and exiting the ring and not for viewing or videotaping. No one will be allowed in ring area to videotape any runs.

Properly distanced chairs will be placed inside marked areas on the floor for exhibitor use but are not allowed to be moved from marked area. No other chairs allowed.

Inside crating will be allowed. Doggie U will place crates in crating areas which can be used by exhibitors but cannot be moved. Exhibitors may place crates in open areas. Exhibitors are not guaranteed that a chair will be next to his/her dog's crate.

No pop-up tent crates allowed inside DU.

There will be a leash runner. Exhibitors will be allowed to put their leash in a pocket or tied around their waist when in the ring.

Limited reserved parking will be available for those exclusively working from their cars.

Pop up canopies and chairs will be placed in the front parking area for exhibitor use.

Important Site Information

Dogs are to remain on leash at all times during trial hours except when in the ring or at the practice jump. This includes all of Fifth Industrial Court and those areas by Essco and Broadway Dairy.

Dog on leash means leash in hand – no loose dogs.

- ❖ **Neighboring complexes directly across from Doggie U are not to be used for exercising your dog, parking and/or training.**
- ❖ Exhibitors are required to clean up after their dogs on all of Fifth Industrial Court
- ❖ All trash is to be placed in proper receptacles
- ❖ No unsupervised children allowed on or about the premises
- ❖ Exhibitors' dogs only allowed in the facility
- ❖ The consumption of alcoholic beverages is prohibited

PARKING

Limited reserved parking will be available for those exclusively working from their cars. Directions on reserving a space will be sent with your confirmation. OBSERVE SIGNS FOR RESERVED SPACES.

There is no parking in front of the building. These areas are reserved for trial officials, handicap parking and exhibitors working out of their car. Parking is allowed along the street and in the lot in front of and around the Master Craft building. There is no parking for RV/oversized vehicles or overnight parking on site. Follow all posted parking directions. **PARKING IS NOT ALLOWED IN CMS LOT. VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED.**

No entries will be accepted by phone, fax, or hand delivery.
Express mail & overnight entries must include signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee.

REFUNDS

After closing date but prior to start of trial: Refund requests for bitches in season will be accepted. Those requests must include a veterinarian's note and be received by the trial secretary before the first run on the first day the bitch is entered in the trial. After the close of entries, \$7.00 will be withheld from refunds for bitches entered in one class, \$11 for two classes or more.

Requests for refunds received after the start of the trial will not be given for any reason. There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date (except for the reasons and conditions listed above) or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of reason for such dismissal. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any cause beyond control of organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the trial Committee.



NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS - SAFETY, BEHAVIOR & LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the event committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made THKC, Feel The Rush Agility Trial Secretary Services and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. THKC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against THKC or any official thereof. **All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.**

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing /Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or AKC Canine Partners listing number, approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word “dog” is used it includes both sexes. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog’s physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from trial grounds

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if dog valid temporary or permanent jump height card has. Otherwise, dogs must be available for measuring prior to start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. Owner/handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. THKC has no responsibility for providing service through public address system or stewards or runners for purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into ring when required. The club agrees to arbitrate claims as set forth on Official AKC Entry Form.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent. A warm-up area, consisting of one regulation agility jump for each ring, may be provided for exhibitors. Warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors on rubber matting. Ring size will be 80’ x 102’.

RIBBONS, AWARDS AND PRIZES

Rosettes will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

First Place	Blue
Second Place.....	Red
Third Place.....	Yellow
Fourth Place.....	White
Qualifying Score.....	Dark Green Ribbon

- ❖ All dogs earning a new title at this event will receive a New Title rosette.
- ❖ All dogs earning a new Master title at this event will receive a New Master Title rosette.
- ❖ All dogs earning a MACH, PACH or PAX will receive a commemorative rosette & bar. If both a PACH & PAX are earned, only one rosette & bar will be presented.
- ❖ ALL PRIZES, AWARDS, ROSETTES AND RIBBONS MUST BE CLAIMED DAY OF TRIAL. NO PRIZES WILL BE MAILED.

THKC NEEDS YOUR HELP

Volunteers guarantee the success of agility trials and keep things running smoothly. Even if you’ve never volunteered before, we welcome and appreciate your help. A link to a Google doc will be sent to all exhibitors after the closing date. Please sign up as soon as possible to ensure you will get your favorite jobs. First time workers – there are many jobs to be done that require enthusiasm only - no experience.

There will be a worker raffle for all volunteer workers.

Thank you for volunteering!

THKC will NOT be providing hospitality for volunteer workers. Doggie U is a private training facility without outside food vendors. There is a McDonalds within walking distance.

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes within the Same Trial Weekend and Multiple Jump Heights within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both regular and preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers with Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class (es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. *Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.*

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION: Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process. When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog needs to be officially measured. Please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs to Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in. Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
