No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each check.

## OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the regulations for Agility A-Match. All classes will take place outdoors on grass. Ring size will be 100' x 100

**REFUNDS - NO** refunds, including bitches in season, after closing date

**MOVE UPS –** As a result of qualifying for an agility title, dogs may be moved o a higher class at the request of the owner, provide the request is made in writing to the Match Secretary no later than 6pm on Monday August 9<sup>th</sup>.

**INCOMPLETE ENTRIES - will** not be processed, an email will be sent to advise of the incomplete entry. Entries must include all the information.

**All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or in the designated warm-up area.**

## HEIGHT DIVISIONS – There will be a VMO at this test.

## DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE

**Showcase for Dogs** 121 North Road, East Windsor, CT 06088

From Rt 91 North: Take Exit 45, take a left at the light at the end of the Exit Ramp, go 1.5 miles and look for the site on the left at Forovan Way.

From Rt 91 South: Take Exit 45, take a right at the light at the end of the Exit Ramp, go 1.5 miles and look for the site on the left at Forovan Way.

**On Site Parking:** Cars are encouraged to park in the parking lot at the end of the driveway. Cars are also allowed on the grass area either side of the driveway. Parking is free. Tenting is allowed under the trees or on the grass areas surrounding the fencing.

**Cool Down Station:** Water hoses and kiddie pools will be available throughout the days. Dogs are welcome to cool down, as necessary.

## Fix and Go On

Fix and Go On allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using Fix and Go On will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run.

## MATCH REGULATIONS – NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

**The Safety of dogs** is our primary concern. By entering this match, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

**Return Checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each return check.

**Telephone, Fax, and Unsigned Entries** can not be accepted.

**Entries Not On Official AKC Entry Forms or Photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules** on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry form are NOT Acceptable. Entries received without fees will not be accepted.

**Entry Fees** shall not be refunded if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or bared from competition by action of Match Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the match can not open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances fire, extreme weather, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other case beyond the control of the organizing committee.

**Errors On Entry** Blanks owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after match has closed.

**Judges Are Not Required To Wait For Dogs.** The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

**Dogs Present** must be always on leash except when in the warm-up area or in the ring. Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. An exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the match committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees will be made. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crate at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. The site will be monitored, and offenders will be asked to leave. In such cases, no refunds will be made. Dogs must use the designated exercise area.

**Match Committee** will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

**Bitches in Season** shall not be eligible to participate. There will be no refunds after entries.

**Dogs Participating** must be 15 months of age or older and must be registered with the American Kennel Club, have an AKC Limited Registration, ILP, PAL, or be FSS breeds eligible to compete. Dogs must be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

**Clean up** all exhibitors must clean up after their dogs.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend, and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? \_\_\_\_\_
