Please enter the correct run number on entry form if only entering one run We anticipate full capacity and will not issue "NO SHOW" refunds for any reason

Overnight entries MUST NOT require a signature. Entries received before the specified opening day or that are incomplete, unsigned or conditional will not be accepted. Day of show entries will be accepted until 3:00 PM as space allows. Tests will be held concurrently.

We will be using a block schedule running order.

Tests will begin promptly at 8:00 AM with workers' dogs and will continue until all runs are completed. Check in is required 30 minutes prior to your time block run time.

THESE TESTS WILL BE HELD ON AN ARTIFICIAL TURF TRACK WITH A SOFT SAND CATCH PEN. TRACK IS LOCATED NEAR THE DOCK DIVING POOL AREA AND WILL UTILIZE AN ELECTRICAL OR GENERATOR POWERED CLOSED LOOP LURE MACHINE. CONTINUOUS FENCING WILL ENCLOSE THE COURSE AND THE RUN OUT.

We will be using a continuous loop lure that will run down the center of the track and will return without obstructing the exit. The lure will consist of plastic bags contrasting in color to the immediate field environment.

There will be no on-site trial briefing.

It is the responsibility of each entrant to be ready when their dog is called to the line. Be sure that your catcher has a leash. Approximately 25 dogs will be scheduled to run each hour.

PLEASE leave the grounds to allow adequate parking for the next block of competitors when your runs are finished.

CHECK IN AND INSPECTION: Check in will occur on a rolling basis throughout the day. The two Fast CAT Tests each day will be run CONCURRENTLY, so a dog entered in both tests will run twice within approximately an hour. Exhibitors will be given an approximate start time and should be available for check in 30 minutes before run time. Check in is immediately followed by inspection for fitness, lameness and bitches in season. Every female dog will be inspected. The dog owner will be required to wipe the dog with a tissue to show the dog is not in season.

Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The Inspection Committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test. Entry fees will be refunded.

All dogs will be measured by a wicket to verify handicaps at check in.

Bitches in season and lame and unfit dogs will be excused with entry fee refunded. Please <u>do not</u> bring bitches in season to the test.

ALL DOGS RUN AT THE SOLE RISK OF THE OWNER

Please bring shade and water for your dog(s)

AWARDS

A light blue participation ribbon will be awarded to each dog attaining a qualifying run. New title rosettes will be awarded for BCAT, DCAT, FCAT and FCAT#.

Please notify the trial secretary, via email or include the information with your entry form, if you anticipate earning a new title. We will TRY to have enough rosettes available at the trial.

FROM THE SOUTH (Nashua) - Everett Turnpike North to Manchester / I-293/101 West. Follow signs towards Rt 101 West (Bedford-Milford) / AK9C is located on Rt. 101, approximately 6 miles from the Rt. 114 interchange. *** AK9C is on the right - 2 miles after Murphy's Taproom, across from Camp Road at the blinking yellow light.

FROM THE SOUTH (Boston) - North to Manchester I-293 to 101 West / Follow signs towards 101 West (Bedford-Milford). See *** above.

FROM THE NORTH (Concord) - South to I-293 toward 101 West. Follow signs towards 101 West (Bedford-Milford). See *** above.

FROM THE EAST COAST - West towards Manchester/Bedford / Follow Rt. 101 West (Bedford-Milford) AK9C is located on Rt. 101, approximately 6 miles from the Rt. 114 interchange. See *** above.

FAST CAT BASICS

WHAT IS Fast CAT?

Fast CAT, unlike the CAT, is not pass/fail, but a timed 100-yard dash after a lure past a start line and over a finish line. Break Beam Timers will be used for this event. If the timers become inoperable, we have stop watches as a backup system.

HOW DOES MY DOG RUN Fast CAT?

Be sure to "warm up" your dog prior to your run. It is equally important to give your dog a "cool down" walk after the run. This will add to the health and well-being of your dog.

Each dog runs one at a time. The dog is held at the start line by the releaser on a course that is completely fenced. Upon word/signal from the Huntsperson, the coursing lure is activated prompting the dog to follow by chasing it to the finish line and into a catch pen. A catcher (often the primary owner) is waiting in the catch pen with a leash to restrain the dog at the end of the run. Once the dog is restrained, they leave the area immediately. Because 20-24 dogs need to run each hour, releasers and catchers must be prompt in getting to their respective locations on time.

ACCORDING TO AKC RULES: Handlers are not permitted to run with a dog during an official run but must remain either at the start or finish area of the course. Handlers are not to allow dogs to be enticed through the course with anything other than the lure during its official run. NO mechanical devices including whistles, horns, bull horns, etc. or toys including the waving of objects to lure the dog to the finish line are allowed. You MAY CHEER and use the dog's name.

COLLARS: Dogs may run without a collar or wear any type of collar except choker collars, electronic training collars, or head collars. Collars should be snug. Hanging tags pose a safety concern and should be secured to the collar with tape or by another means. Dogs may run muzzled if desired. Clips or rubber bands may be used to keep long hair from falling across the dog's field of vision.

HOW DOES MY DOG EARN AN AKC TITLE FOR A Fast CAT?

The time of the dog's run is converted to miles per hour (MPH) and then multiplied by a handicap based on the dog's height at the withers to award points.

FORMULA: 204.545 / RUN TIME = MPH

- 18" or greater = Handicap is 1.0
- 12" up to less than 18" = Handicap is 1.5.
- Under 12" = Handicap is 2.0 FORMULA: MPH X HANDICAP = POINTS

Titles are earned by accumulating points. The following titles will be awarded: BCAT = 150 points; DCAT = 500 points; FCAT = 1,000 points; and FCAT followed by a number (e.g. FCAT2) for every additional 500 points. These suffix titles will appear on a dog's pedigree with a higher-level title superseding a lower-level title.

Top 20 by Breed by Year

The AKC Fast CAT website features the Top 20 fastest dogs by breed for each year. Dogs must complete at least 3 qualifying runs in each calendar year to qualify for **the Top 20**. The standings will be updated as event results are processed at https://www.apps.akc.org/apps/fastcat_ranking/

NOTICES

All dogs entered must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the test.

Dogs should be warmed up before and cooled down after running. Have plenty of water for your dogs.

ALL DOGS RUN AT THE SOLE RISK OF THE OWNER

Dogs must be on lead or crated unless running. You are responsible for controlling your dog(s). You must bring your own crates and water dishes.

There will be a \$5 fine assessed for any loose dog not taking part in the course in progress, for anyone caught not picking up after their dog, or for leaving garbage on the grounds.

Bitches in season and lame dogs will be excused.

This is a rain-or-shine outdoor event. Please plan accordingly. Please bring your own shade, chairs, and water.

Cool Down Station: Water hoses and kiddie pools will be available throughout the days. Dogs are welcome to cool down, as necessary

On-site toilets (port-o-potties) are available.

NO ONE will be allowed on the field without the express permission of the event chairman, except the appointed event committee.

All AKC rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply. Anyone exhibiting unsportsmanlike behavior will be excused from the field and may be subject to further disciplinary action.

Any person, upon reasonable complaint, may be asked to leave the grounds by the event committee and may be disciplined by the AKC. Children must be under control of their parent(s) or guardian(s) at all times.

ACNH and its members, American K9 Country and Feel The Rush Trials are not to be held responsible for any accidents at these tests. The event committee reserves the right to bar known aggressive dogs from the event site.

The event-hosting club, the ACNH, its agents, members, representatives, volunteers, etc., assume no liability or responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators before, during, or after this event.

The ACNH at their discretions has the right to cancel any event without notice due to inclement weather or unsafe field conditions which it deems an endangerment to the dogs or their owners.
