### **CERTIFICATION**

### For all dogs at least 12 months of age And individually registered with the AKC

This includes all AKC registered purebreds, Foundation Stock Service (FSS), Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) and AKC Canine Partners. Spayed or neutered dogs or dogs with breed disqualifications may be entered.

CHECK IN AND INSPECTION. Check In will occur on a rolling basis throughout the day. The two Fast CAT Tests each day will be run CONCURRENTLY, so a dog entered in both Tests will run twice within an hour or so. Exhibitors will be given an approximate start time and should be available for Check In an hour before run time. Check In is then immediately followed by Inspection for fitness, lameness, or "in season" females. Each female dog will be inspected. The dog owner will be required to wipe the dog with tissue to show the dog is not in season. All dogs will be measured by a wicket to verify handicaps.

Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The inspection committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test and, in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded.

Bitches in season, lame, and unfit dogs will be excused with entry refunded. Please do not bring bitches in season to the Entries Open: June 24th at 12:00 noon ET test.

Entries Close: August 20, at 6pm ET

### PLEASE ENTER THE CORRECT EVENT NUMBER on ENTRY FORM WE ANTICIPATE FULL CAPACITY AND WILL NOT ISSUE "NO SHOW" REFUNDS FOR ANY REASON

THESE TESTS WILL BE HELD ON MOWED GRASS AND UTILIZE AN ELECTRICAL OR GENERATOR POWERED CLOSED LOOP LURE MACHINE. CONTINUOUS CHAIN LINK AND WELDED WIRE FENCING WILL ENCLOSE THE COURSE. The lure will consist of plastic bags contrasting in color to the immediate field environment.

#### **Fast CAT SETUP**

Depending on the weather and ground conditions, we may use back field which has a 140-foot run out or the front field which has a 140-foot run out. Both Fast CAT Tracks and run outs are fully fenced.

Break Beam Timers will be used. Back-up timers are available on site. If all timers become inoperable, stop watches will be used as a backup system.

We will be using a continuous loop lure. The lure will run down the center of the track and will return without obstructing the exit.

### WHAT MUST MY DOG DO TO PASS A Fast CAT?

A dog must complete the course to qualify and earn points.

### **CAN MY DOG EARN AN AKC TITLE FOR Fast CAT?**

Titles are earned by accumulating points. The following titles will be awarded: BCAT = 150 points; DCAT = 500 points; FCAT = 1,000 points; and FCAT followed by a number (e.g. FCAT2) for every additional 500 points. These suffix titles will appear on a dog's pedigree, with a higher-level title superseding a lower level title.

#### What is the Fast CAT?

- 1. Fast CAT is a timed straight 100-yard dash for dogs.
- 2. Dogs are held at the start line and the coursing lure is activated prompting the dog to chase it to the finish line and into a catch pen. The course is completely fenced, and dogs are run individually.
- 3. The time is converted to miles per hour (MPH).

FORMULA: 204.545 / RUN TIME = MPH Based on the dog's size at the withers, a handicap is applied to calculate points earned

- 18" or greater = Handicap is 1.0
- 12" up to less than 18" = Handicap is 1.5.
- Under 12" = Handicap is 2.0. (ROUNDED TO NEAREST 0.01)
- 4. FORMULA: MPH X HANDICAP = POINTS
- 5. Titles are earned at specific point levels and the highest suffix may appear after the dog's name:

BCAT = 150 points

DCAT = 500 points

FCAT = 1,000 points

FCAT# = Each additional 500 points

The AKC Fast CAT website will feature the Top 20 By Breed and By Year. Dogs must complete at least 3 qualifying runs in each calendar year to qualify for **the Top 20.** The standings will be updated as event results are processed at https://www.apps.akc.org/apps/fastcat\_ranking

ACCORDING TO AKC RULES: Handlers are not permitted to run with a dog during an official run but must remain either at the start or finish area of the course. Handlers are not allowed to entice dogs through the course with anything other than the lure during its official run. NO mechanical devices including whistles, horns, bull horns, etc. or toys including the waving of objects to lure the dog to the finish line are allowed. Handlers MAY CHEER and use the dog's name.

Be prompt at the start line when your number is called. It is best to have one person release your dog and have the primary owner calling and catching the dog at the finish line in the catch area.

Collar Rules: Dogs may run without a collar or wear any type of collar except choker collars, electronic training collars or head collar. Collars should be snug. Hanging tags pose a safety concern and it is recommended that tags be secured to the collar with tape. Dogs may run muzzled if desired. Clips or rubber bands may be used to keep long hair from falling across the dog's field of vision.

### **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

All exhibitors and visitors must comply with current state, local and site Covid-19 policies in effect on the event dates.

#### ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNER'S SOLE RISK

All entries must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the test.

All AKC rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply.

This is a rain-or-shine outdoor event. Please plan accordingly. Please bring your own shade, chairs, and water.

On-site bathrooms (port-a-potties) are available.

Dogs should be warmed up before and cooled down after running.

Dogs must be on lead or crated unless running. A fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field not competing, or an exhibitor caught not picking up after their dog or leaving trash at the site.

You are responsible for controlling your dog(s) and children.

Bitches in season and lame dogs will be excused. Entry fees will be refunded.

No Boomerang on the track is allowed per AKC rules.

Any person, upon reasonable complaint, may be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Committee and may be disciplined by the AKC. Children must always be under control of their parent(s) or guardian(s).

Neither Yankee Weimaraner Club and Tar Tan Gordon Setter Club and its members, Showcase for Dogs, or Feel The Rush Trials will be held responsible for any accidents at these tests. The field committee reserves the right to bar known aggressive dogs from the event site.

NO ONE will be allowed on the field without the express permission of the event chair or event committee.

Anybody exhibiting unsportsmanlike behavior will be excused from the field and may be subject to further disciplinary action.

Control of dogs strictly enforced; dogs must always be on leash except when running.

**FOOd:** No food will be available on the grounds. Please bring your own food and beverages or visit one of the several food establishments nearby.

**Entry Fees** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the event, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snowstorms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event, it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.
