Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

### **OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS**

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors on FieldTurf. Ring 1 130' x 90'. All equipment is provided by Premier Sports Center. ALL ISC CLASSES will have 4.3 feet jump bars except for the back bars in any spread which will be 5 feet bars. Any ISC classes that have a broad jump will be using the ascending (FCI) style broad jump and any iSC classes that have a tire will be using the FCI heights for the Tire.

No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each check.

**REFUNDS - After closing date but prior to start of trial:**

**Refund requests for bitches in season, for injured or sick dogs and for injured handlers will be accepted. These must include a veterinarian's or doctor's note and be received by the trial secretary before the first run on the first day of the trial. After the close of entries, \$7.00 per run will be withheld from refunds.**

Requests for refunds received after the start of the trial will not be given for any reason. There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date (except for the reasons and conditions listed above) or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of reason for such dismissal. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any cause beyond control of organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the trial Committee.

### **DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER**

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing /Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or AKC Canine Partners listing number, approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used it includes both sexes. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from trial grounds.

### **COURSE WALK-THROUGHS INFORMATION**

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent. A warm-up area, consisting of one regulation agility jump for each ring, may be provided for exhibitors. Warm-up areas are to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving the dog.

### **RINGSIDE**

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, dogs must be available for measuring prior to start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. Owner/handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. **GSCA** has no responsibility for providing service through public address system or stewards or runners for purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into ring when required. The club agrees to arbitrate claims as set forth on Official AKC Entry Form.

## MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION.

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

### NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog needs to be officially measured. Please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs To Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. **GSCA & Feel The Rush Agility Trial Secretary Services** and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. **GSCA** reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the **GSCA** or any official thereof. **All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.**

Merge onto NJ-54 N/12th St. Turn right onto Bellevue Ave. Continue onto US-206 N/Trenton Rd. At traffic circle, take 3rd exit onto NJ-70 W. Turn right onto County Rt 685. Continue onto Eayrestown Rd. Turn right onto Coleman Ct.

**FROM DELAWARE MEMORIAL BRIDGE AND SOUTH:** keep right towards Camden / Trenton. Merge onto I295 N. Take exit 34A for NJ-70 E/Marlton Pike E/ W RT 70. Continue on NJ-70 E. Turn left onto Red Lion Rd. Turn left onto Eayrestown Rd. Turn right onto Coleman Ct.

**FROM PHILADELPHIA:** - From the Ben Franklin bridge, take RT 30 E/Route 676 S exit on left toward RT 130/38/70/Cherry Hill/Camden Waterfront. Continue onto US-30 E (keep left). ### **Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day**

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the

same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

## **For Exhibition Only (FEO)**

FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.

- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).

- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handler's hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used.

- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring

- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.

- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time.

## Fix and Go On

Fix and Go On allow exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using Fix and Go On will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run.

### ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

**GSCA** and Premier Sports Center will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

**NO** Food vendor at this trial.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without the benefit of a refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show site.

### WAIT LIST INFORMATION

**GSCA** is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 25 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior **Thursday June 4, 2026, at 6pm est.** Any entries withdrawn that are received by **Thursday June 4, 2026, at 6pm est** that are replaced by a wait list entry will receive a full refund for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off wait list into the trial by **Monday June 8th, 2026 at 6pm est** will receive a full refund. (Trial Secretary will destroy entry and check).

## INTERNATIONAL SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES (ISC):

**This event is NOT World Team Qualifying Event, meaning there will NOT be an automatic invite of the combined winners to WTT.**

### ISC level description & info:

- A1 (STD 1) and J1 (JWW 1) are the beginning levels of FCI/ISC Courses.
- A2 (STD 2) and J2 (JWW 2) are the intermediate levels of FCI/ISC Courses.
- A3 (STD 3) and J3 (JWW 3) are the master levels of FCI/ISC Courses.

Teams may enter any / all levels offered daily.

**Purpose:** The International Sweepstakes Class (ISC) is a non-regular class providing the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various International Style Standard and Jumpers with Weaves courses. The rules for this class are generally based on international rules. The variety in International Agility course designs is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the "Challenge of the Day" when competing in the ISC class. The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult, or simply different from what is currently allowed in Excellent / Master Classes. Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC Website (<http://www.akc.org>)

**Eligibility:** ISC classes are open to dogs that are eligible to compete in AKC agility trials. Competitors are eligible to enter any and multiple levels in the same day. **There is NO Preferred option for ISC; dogs may enter and jump at their Preferred jump height;** however, they will be scored against their respective regular jump height peers.

**Qualifications:** "Clean run" scores for dogs who measure into ISC heights in the 12", 16", 20" and 24" classes may be used toward fulfilling the requirements for WTT/EOTT. A "clean run" consists of a run without time or course faults. \*As of January 2023, Level 1 clean runs do NOT count toward WTT qualifiers, only Levels 2 and 3. All levels count towards EOTT qualifiers.

**ISC Jump Heights:** Dogs may enter at their regular AKC jump height or their preferred height. Only those dogs running in the 12", 16", 20 and 24" classes that meet the FCI/ISC measuring cutoff (different than regular AKC cutoffs) will be eligible for their score to count towards the qualification to WTT or EOTT. The FCI/ISC cutoffs for these heights are:

- Small (12" jump height) - for dogs measuring 13  $\frac{3}{4}$ " or less at the withers.
- Medium (16" jump height) - for dogs measuring more than 13  $\frac{3}{4}$ " but less than 16  $\frac{7}{8}$ " at the withers.
- Intermediate (20" jump height) – for dogs measuring more than 16  $\frac{7}{8}$ " but less than 18  $\frac{7}{8}$ "
- Large (24" jump height) – for dogs measuring over 18  $\frac{7}{8}$ " at the withers.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. INSTRUCTIONS. Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners ProgramSM may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
