TRIAL CANCELLATIONS TO BE POSTED TO CENTRAL K9 FACEBOOK & WEBSITE

THESE TESTS WILL BE HELD ON MOWED GRASS AND WILL UTILIZE AN ELECTRICAL OR GENERATOR POWERED CLOSED LOOP LURE MACHINE. CONTINUOUS WIRE FENCING WILL ENCLOSE THE COURSE AND THE RUN OUT.

We will be using a continuous loop lure that will run down the center of the track and will return without obstructing the exit. The lure will consist of plastic bags contrasting in color to the immediate field environment.

Tests will be held concurrently.

We will be using a block schedule running order.

After entries close, you will be emailed a confirmation of the time slot.

If you enter online, you can select your time slot for both tests.

Tests will begin promptly at 8:00 AM with workers' dogs and will continue until all runs are completed. Check in 30 minutes prior to your run time.

Simple and ongoing briefings will occur in conjunction with Check In and Inspection.

It is the responsibility of each entrant to be ready when their dog is called to the line. Be sure that the catcher has a leash.

24+ dogs will be scheduled to run each hour.

Once all your runs are completed you MUST leave the grounds unless you are working for the Club.

CHECK IN AND INSPECTION. Check In will occur on a rolling basis throughout the day. The two Fast CAT Tests each day will be run CONCURRENTLY, so a dog entered in both Tests will run twice within an hour or so. Exhibitors will be given an approximate start time and should be available for Check In an hour before run time. Check In is then immediately followed by Inspection for fitness, lameness, or "in season" females. Each female dog will be inspected. The dog owner will be required to wipe the dog with tissue to show the dog is not in season. All dogs will be measured by a wicket to verify handicaps.

Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The inspection committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test and, in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded.

Bitches in season, lame, and unfit dogs will be excused with entry refunded. Please do not bring bitches in season to the test.

WE ANTICIPATE FULL CAPACITY AND WILL NOT ISSUE "NO SHOW" REFUNDS FOR ANY REASON

AWARDS

A light blue participation ribbon will be awarded to each dog attaining a qualifying run.

New title rosettes will be awarded BCAT, DCAT, FCAT and FCAT#.

You must pick up your ribbon(s) during the day of the trial; qualifying ribbons and title ribbons will not be mailed.

TEST HOURS:

First dog on the line 8:00 am, Volunteer dogs will run first from 8am to 9am. Tests will run CONCURRENTLY each day. Please check in 30 minutes prior to your run time

Any exhibitor who allows his/her dogs to be loose and unattended in a room or to do damage to hotel property, and who then does not immediately contact the hotel management to make proper restitution, will be subject to Event Committee action which could result in the loss of AKC privileges. FAST CAT BASICS

WHAT IS Fast CAT?

Fast CAT, unlike the CAT, is not pass/fail, but a timed 100-yard dash after a lure past a start line and over a finish line. Break Beam Timers will be used for this event. If the timers become inoperable, we have stop watches as a backup system.

HOW DOES MY DOG RUN Fast CAT?

Be sure to “warm up” your dog prior to your run. It is equally important to give your dog a “cool down” walk after the run. This will add to the health and well-being of your dog.

Each dog runs one at a time. The dog is held at the start line by the releaser on a course that is completely fenced. Upon word/signal from the Huntsperson, the coursing lure is activated prompting the dog to follow by chasing it to the finish line and into a catch pen. A catcher (often the primary owner) is waiting in the catch pen with a leash to restrain the dog at the end of the run. Once the dog is restrained, they leave the area immediately. Because 20-24 dogs need to run each hour, releasers and catchers must be prompt in getting to their respective locations on time.

ACCORDING TO AKC RULES: Handlers are not permitted to run with a dog during an official run but must remain either at the start or finish area of the course. Handlers are not to allow dogs to be enticed through the course with anything other than the lure during its official run. NO mechanical devices including whistles, horns, bull horns, etc. or toys including the waving of objects to lure the dog to the finish line are allowed. You **MAY CHEER** and use the dog’s name.

COLLARS: Dogs may run without a collar or wear any type of collar except choker collars, electronic training collars, or head collars. Collars should be snug. Hanging tags pose a safety concern and should be secured to the collar with tape or by another means. Dogs may run muzzled if desired. Clips or rubber bands may be used to keep long hair from falling across the dog’s field of vision.

HOW DOES MY DOG EARN AN AKC TITLE FOR Fast CAT?

The time of the dog’s run is converted to miles per hour (MPH) and then multiplied by a handicap based on the dog’s height at the withers to award points.

FORMULA: $204.545 / \text{RUN TIME} = \text{MPH}$

- 18” or greater = Handicap is 1.0
- 12” up to less than 18” = Handicap is 1.5.
- Under 12” = Handicap is 2.0

FORMULA: $\text{MPH} \times \text{HANDICAP} = \text{POINTS}$

Titles are earned by accumulating points. The following titles will be awarded:

BCAT = 150 points

DCAT = 500 points

FCAT = 1,000 points; and FCAT followed by a number (e.g. FCAT2) for every additional 500 points. These suffix titles will appear on a dog’s pedigree, with a higher-level title superseding a lower-level title.

The AKC Fast CAT website features the Top 20 fastest dogs by breed for each year. Dogs must complete at least 3 qualifying runs in each calendar year to qualify for **the Top 20**. The standings will be updated as event results are processed at https://www.apps.akc.org/apps/fastcat_ranking.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

All dogs entered must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the test.

Dogs should be warmed up before and cooled down after running. Have plenty of water for your dogs.

ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNER'S SOLE RISK.

Dogs must be on lead or crated unless running. You are responsible for controlling your dog(s). You must bring your own crates and water dishes.

There will be a \$5 fine assessed for any loose dog not taking part in the course in progress, for anyone caught not picking up after their dog, or for leaving garbage on the grounds.

The Inspection Committee will excuse bitches in season and lame dogs, and the Club will refund entry fees.

This is a rain-or-shine outdoor event. Please plan accordingly. Please bring your own shade, chairs and water.

On site toilets (port-o-potties) are available.

NO ONE will be allowed on the field without the express permission of the event chairperson, except the appointed event committee. No one may use the pools or areas not designated for these Fastcat trials.

All AKC rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply. Anyone exhibiting unsportsmanlike behavior will be excused from the field and may be subject to further disciplinary action.

Any person, upon reasonable complaint, may be asked to leave the grounds by the event committee and may be disciplined by the AKC. Children must be always under control of their parent(s) or guardian(s).

Connecticut Valley Vizsla Club & Vizsla Club of Central New England and its members, Central K9 LLC and Feel The Rush Trials are not to be held responsible for any accidents at these tests. The event committee reserves the right to bar known aggressive dogs from the event site.

Connecticut Valley Vizsla Club & Vizsla Club of Central New England its agents, members, representatives, volunteers, etc., assume no liability or responsibility for any loss, damage, injury, or sickness sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or any of their dogs or property. and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators before, during, or after this event.

Connecticut Valley Vizsla Club & Vizsla Club of Central New England at their discretion, has the right to cancel any event without notice due to inclement weather or unsafe field conditions that it deems endangerment to the dogs or their owners. No entry fee will be refunded.

Food: No food will be available on the grounds. Please bring your own food and beverages or visit one of the several food establishments nearby. No smoking or alcohol is allowed on the premises.

Flex leads are not to be used in highly trafficked areas

Any damages done by an uncontrolled dog will be the financial responsibility of the dog owner and must be paid within three weeks of the event to Central K9 unless other arrangements have been made.

State law requires a proof of rabies vaccination. Please carry proof of rabies vaccination if asked to present it by CVVC & VCCNE or Central K9

Severe discipline, physical punishment and/or abuse in any form will not be tolerated. Any handler/owner demonstrating severe punishment will be asked to leave the grounds and their entry will not be refunded
